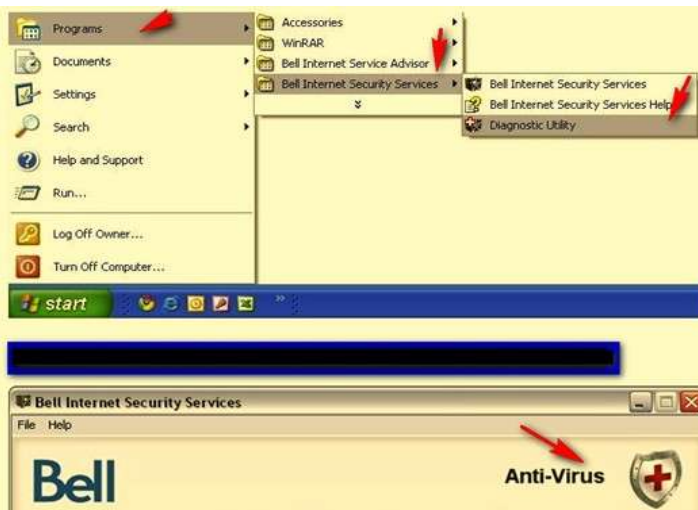

If you get the above displayed, you have it installed.

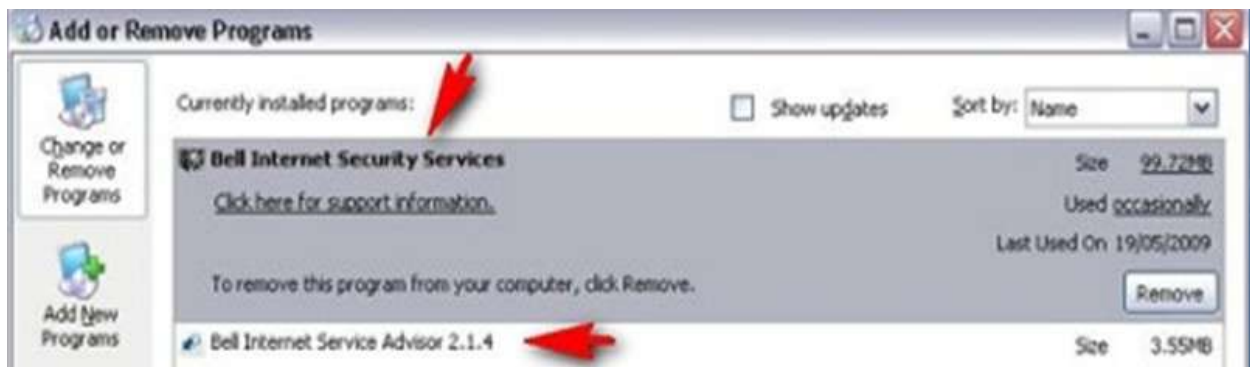

To uninstall Bell Internet Security Manager, follow these instructions:

- 1 Click on Start, Control Panel, Bell Internet Security Manager.
- 2 Shut it down by clicking File, then Exit.



- 3 Double-click Add or Remove Programs.
- 4 Select Bell Internet Security Manager and click Remove. Follow the prompts to completely remove it and restart the computer.
- 5 Then go back to Add or Remove Programs, Select Bell Internet Security Advisor and click Remove. Follow the prompts to completely remove it.
- 6 Install one of the AV programs we reviewed. See Show Time on our website, "Which Anti Virus Program is Right for You – 14 December, 2010"
- 7 Inform Bell re uninstall.
